We must have at least five posters per grade in order to judge categories, which are as follows: (K-1), (2-3), (4-5).

Due Date: Posters will need to be turned into the South River EMC office before 5 p.m. on Friday, October 8. Posters will be judged in the office and South River EMC will contact winners.

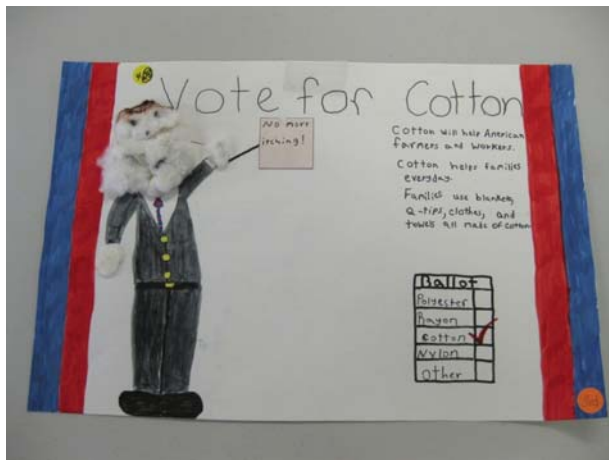

Contest Rules:

- The theme of the poster must be cotton.
- Art must be 12" x 18" sturdy materials such as foam board, etc. Larger and/or smaller artwork will not be accepted.
- The art will be judged on use of the theme, neatness, creativity, and age appropriateness (the work must be the child's own).
- Submissions must include the child's name, age, school, grade and home phone number on the back of the posters.
- Limit one entry per child.
- All information must be written neatly on the back of the poster.

Prizes:

- Touchstone Energy Cotton Festival first place winners will receive a special prize, ride wristband (for the festival), a festival t-shirt, a medal and a certificate.
- Touchstone Energy Cotton Festival second place winners will receive a festival t-shirt, a medal and a certificate.
- Grade winners from each school will receive a prize and a certificate of participation.
